1. Alabama

A one-time tax rebate has been issued: \$150 for single filers and \$300 for married couples. Eligibility requires filing 2021 taxes by October 17, 2022. The rebate, funded by a \$2.8 billion surplus in the state's Education Trust Fund, will reach about 1.9 million residents at an estimated cost of \$383 million.

2. Arizona

By April 15, Arizona taxpayers with dependents will receive rebates. For each dependent under 17, there is a \$250 rebate, capped at \$750 for three dependents. Dependents aged 17 and older will earn \$100 each. This rebate, supported by the Arizona Freedom Caucus, aims to alleviate inflation impacts using state surplus funds. Approximately 750,000 taxpayers who filed their 2021 returns and claimed specific credits will benefit.

3. Georgia

Taxpayers who haven't filed 2021 or 2022 state income tax returns are encouraged to do so to qualify for a potential one-time tax credit. Single filers can receive up to \$250, heads of household up to \$375, and married couples filing jointly up to \$500.

4. Illinois

Residents may receive unclaimed property checks up to \$5,000. Over 66,000 individuals could qualify for approximately \$47 million in total. Claimants should watch for a letter from the Illinois State Treasurer's Office and may need to verify their identity to receive a paper check.

5. Minnesota

A one-time tax rebate, up to \$1,300, began distribution in mid-August. Specific amounts and eligibility criteria are detailed in the official guidelines.

6. Montana

Rebates for income and property taxes for 2021 and 2022 are expected for residents who filed by October 1, 2023. Rebates include up to \$675 for property tax and/or an income tax rebate equal to the lesser of \$2,500 for joint filers (\$1,250 for other classifications) or their state tax liability.

7. New Mexico

Economic Relief Payments started on July 26, 2023, providing \$500 for individuals and \$1,000 for couples and households, benefiting 26,085 qualifying applicants.

8. Pennsylvania

The Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program application deadline was May 1, 2024. Eligibility and rebate amounts are detailed on the official website.

9. Virginia

Virginia offers a \$200 tax rebate to individuals with tax liability in 2022, and a \$400 rebate for joint filers. Taxpayers who file by July 1, 2024, are expected to receive rebates by December 2024. The filing deadline for rebate eligibility is July 2024.

10. Washington State

Eligible workers may receive up to \$1,200 through the Washington Working Families Tax Credit Refund. Applications must be submitted by December 31, 2024.
